# Welcome to Tirana!

Tirana is the capital and largest city of Albania. It is located in the centre of the country, enclosed by mountains and hills, with Dajti rising to the east and a slight valley to the northwest overlooking the Adriatic Sea in the distance. It is among the wettest and sunniest cities in Europe, with 2,544 hours of sun per year.

Here are some interesting facts about Tirana :

## 1. Tirana Wasn't Always the Capital

It's a relatively young capital, officially designated in 1920.

## 2. Abandoned Military Installations

Throughout the city and scattered across the Albanian countryside, one can find over 700,000 military bunkers

## 3. Tirana's climate is Mediterranean type.

The average daily high temperature in summer is around 28 degrees Celsius, and for winter, it is 14 degrees.

## 4. The love for coffee

Tirana has approximately 1,000 coffee shops.

## 5. A network of museums and galleries to visit.

Tirana is the center for Arts and Culture in Albania.

## 6. The city of colors

One of the most striking visual aspects of Tirana is its vibrantly painted buildings.

## Arrival and Orientation in Tirana, Albania

Airport information: Tirana International Airport (TIA), also known as Mother Teresa Airport, is located approximately 17 kilometers northwest of the city center of Tirana.

## Facilities and services:

- Currency Exchange: Available at the airport for convenient currency conversion.
- At the airport there is an ATM for currency exchange.
- There are shops that offer SIM cards and mobile services.
- There are several car rental agencies.
- Restaurants and bars are available in the terminal.

## Transportation Options

1. **Taxis:** Taxis are readily available outside the arrivals area. It's recommended to use official taxis and agree on a fare or ensure the meter is used. A taxi from Tirana airport to the city center costs €20 – €25 for a one-way trip. Another option is using electric taxis, which are eco-friendly and have lower operating costs, starting from €12. Here are some electric taxi companies: Blue Taxi, Lux Taxi, Green Taxi etc.
2. **Airport Shuttle Bus:** A shuttle bus service runs regularly between the airport and Tirana city center, providing an affordable transportation option. From Tirana airport, you can take a shuttle bus to the city center of Tirana. The timetable: 8:00AM until 23:00PM. The shuttle bus brings you from Tirana International airport to the center of Tirana. The bus drops you off at Skanderbeg Square, which is the central square of Tirana.
3. **Car Rentals:** Available for those who prefer to drive.



# Faculty of Dental Medicine



## ❖ The mission of the Faculty of Dental Medicine

The Faculty of Dental Medicine, University of Medicine, Tirana mission consists of:

- Education of students in all three study cycles, in accordance with the highest professional standards;
- The best possible preparation of professionals, able to practice optimal patient care, aiming at the prevention and treatment of dental pathologies;
- Stimulation to advance scientific research.



## ❖ History of the Faculty of Dental Medicine

In 1959, next to the Faculty of Medicine, the Department of Dentistry was established. In 1964, this branch was organized into three separate branches: Therapy, Oro Maxillo-Facial Surgery and Prosthodontics.

In 1998, these three branches were united, forming a single Department. This way of organization continued until 2011, when, as a result of its dissolution, three relevant sections were created with mutual services in function of the Departments of: Therapy, Oro-Maxillo-Facial Surgery and Prosthodontics.

The Faculty of Dental Medicine was created as a new structure, part of the University of Medicine, Tirana based on Decision of the Council of Ministers No. 43, dated 23.01.2013.

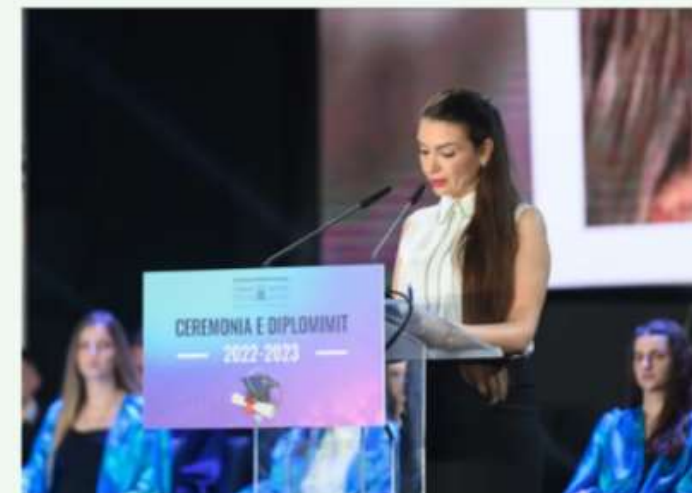




## ❖ Organization of studies

The studies are organized as follows:

1. **First cycle**, Bachelor in "Dental Technician" and "Dental Hygienist", with a duration of 3 years, at the end of which, the student is awarded a Bachelor's Degree in "Dental Hygienist" and "Dental Technician".
2. **Integrated cycle of the second level**, with a duration of 5 years, at the end of which, the student is awarded the "Master of Science in Dentistry" Diploma.
3. **Long-term specialization programs**, of the third cycle of studies, in the field of Dental Medicine (duration 2-4 years). The specialization study programs are: "Dental Therapy", "Pedodontics" in the Department of Therapy, "Maxillofacial Surgery" in the Department of Surgery. In 2023, the Orthodontics program was opened for the first time, in the Prosthodontic Department.
4. **Doctoral studies**. Since 2010, 25 doctoral students have been registered in the Doctorate program, who have defended the scientific degree "Doctor". The doctoral students have completed their doctoral defenses in the jury, after undergoing the anti-plagiarism process. For 10 years, there have been no new doctoral studies at the University of Medicine. In 2023, the new doctoral program was opened, where 19 candidates were accepted.

# FMD LIBRARY

## How is library organized?

The Scientific Library of the Faculty of Dental Medicine has a fund of 200 titles of books and periodicals. The books are organized according to the disciplines they belong to. Most of them are books in the Albanian language and in foreign languages, mainly English, German, Italian. Only 30 titles are periodicals. This includes the Albanian Dental Journals, published since 1990, as well as journals from the European Dental Associations. The library offers professional service and helps the readers with guidance and suggestions for choosing the literature they need during their studies and research work. The FMD Scientific Library has about 500 members (students, lecturers and dentists). They can become members of the library based on completing a documentation, for a period of 1 year.

## How the library works?

The library has a 30-seat reading room, which can be used by students from Monday to Friday according to a set schedule. A few months ago, the complete list of library units was drawn up, which can also be accessed on the website of the Faculty of Dental Medicine. Currently, the library does not borrow library material, due to the small number of copies of literature.



# LANGUAGE

- The language used in scientific activities offered by the Faculty of Dentistry and the University of Medicine, Tirana, both in the formal and informal context, is the Albanian and English language.
- The subject of English language is included in our curricula in the first year of the undergraduate studies.
- Students who apply to be admitted to second or third cycle study programs in higher education institutions must have a certified level of knowledge through international tests for one of the 5 (five) foreign languages, namely: English language, French language, German language, Italian language and Spanish language, according to the definitions in the instructions of the Ministry of Education and Sports.



# Introduction to Dormitories: What to Expect?

## 1. University housing options:

Dormitories for students of the University of Medicine offer accommodation options for students studying in our Faculty.

Below are some key details:

- **Shared Rooms:** These rooms are shared with two to four students, creating a shared and more economical atmosphere. Furnishings: Rooms are furnished with the basic necessities for living, including beds, tables, chairs and storage space.
- **Shared Kitchens and Bathrooms:** Shared spaces include kitchens and bathrooms, equipped with the necessary tools for cooking and hygiene.
- **Study Areas:** Special study spaces are available, offering a quiet environment for academic preparation.
- **Security:** Security is guaranteed with constant surveillance and 24/7 security guards. Maintenance Services: Maintenance staff is available to resolve technical and other problems that may arise.

# WHAT TO VISIT IN TIRANA?

1. **Skanderbeg Square:** The central square in Tirana, named after the national hero Skanderbeg, is surrounded by important landmarks like the National History Museum and the Et'hem Bey Mosque.
2. **Bunk'Art Museums:** Two museums, Bunk'Art 1 and Bunk'Art 2, offer a glimpse into Albania's communist past, housed in underground bunkers.
3. **Mount Dajti National Park:** Accessible by cable car, this park offers panoramic views of Tirana and opportunities for hiking and picnicking.
4. **House of Leaves Museum** The House of Leaves Museum is another unique museum in Tirana that tells the story of the country's Communist past.
5. **Petrelë Castle** : Its history dates back to the 6th century, when it was built by the Byzantine emperor Justinian I.
6. **Tirana Pyramid:** Originally built as a museum for Enver Hoxha, Albania's former dictator, it is now a notable architectural landmark.
7. **Grand Park of the Lake** : Described as the "green lung" of the capital, the Artificial Lake park continues to remain one of the most frequented areas in Tirana.
8. **The National Historical Museum** : It is the largest museum institution in Albania and one of the most important.
9. **The New Bazar** : It's a space that operates 24 hours, with the biggest focus on product trade in the morning hours and on culinary issues in the afternoon for the restaurants around.
